Subject: Rules relating to the Election of Chief Minister, Deputy Chief Minister, Ministers and Chairmen

Proposition: Amendment
Proposed by: Deputy M. H. Dorey

To delete the Proposition numbered "1" and to substitute therefor:

"To agree that Rule 20 of the Rules of Procedure of the States of Deliberation be amended with immediate effect as follows:

1. *Delete sub-paragraph (3)(d) and substitute:*

"(d) at the election meeting, before voting takes places the Presiding Officer shall –

(i) invite each candidate (or the candidate if there is only one) to speak for not more than 10 minutes; and thereafter

(ii) allow Members to question the candidate(s), provided that

(1) no Member may ask more than one question;

(2) the questioner may not speak for more than 30 seconds;

(3) each candidate shall be entitled to respond to each question, but no response shall exceed 1 minute;

(4) where, applicable, the order of answering the questions shall, after each question has been answered by the candidates, be rotated by moving the name of the candidate at the top of the list to the bottom of that list;

(5) the session shall conclude at the expiration of the period calculated by multiplying 30 minutes by the number of candidates; and

(6) no Member shall be entitled to speak other than in accordance with the provisions of this sub-paragraph."

2. *Delete paragraph (4) and substitute:*

“(4) On a proposition to elect a Minister or a Deputy Chief Minister:

- (a) the Presiding Officer shall first invite the Chief Minister, and thereafter other Members, to propose eligible candidates. Nobody shall speak about a candidate at that stage; and if only one candidate is proposed and seconded the Presiding Officer shall put the election of that candidate to the vote without speeches;*
- (b) if more than one candidate is proposed, before voting takes place the Presiding Officer shall –*
 - (i) invite each candidate to speak for not more than 10 minutes; and thereafter*
 - (ii) allow Members to question the candidates, provided that*
 - (1) no Member may ask more than one question;*
 - (2) the questioner may not speak for more than 30 seconds;*
 - (3) each candidate shall be entitled to respond to each question, but no response shall exceed 1 minute;*
 - (4) the order of answering the questions shall, after each question has been answered by the candidates, be rotated by moving the name of the candidate at the top of the list to the bottom of that list*
 - (5) the session shall conclude at the expiration of the period calculated by multiplying 30 minutes by the number of candidates; and*
 - (6) no Member shall be entitled to speak other than in accordance with the provisions of this sub-paragraph.”.*

3. *Delete paragraph (5) and substitute:*

“(5) On a proposition to elect a Chairman of a Committee:

- (a) the Presiding Officer shall first invite Members to propose eligible candidates. Nobody shall speak about a candidate at that stage; and if only one candidate is proposed and seconded the Presiding*

Officer shall put the election of that candidate to the vote without speeches;

- (b) if more than one candidate is proposed, before voting takes place the Presiding Officer shall –*
 - (i) invite each candidate to speak for not more than 10 minutes; and thereafter*
 - (ii) allow Members to question the candidates, provided that*
 - (1) no Member may ask more than one question;*
 - (2) the questioner may not speak for more than 30 seconds;*
 - (3) each candidate shall be entitled to respond to each question, but no response shall exceed 1 minute;*
 - (4) the order of answering the questions shall, after each question has been answered by the candidates, be rotated by moving the name of the candidate at the top of the list to the bottom of that list*
 - (5) the session shall conclude at the expiration of the period calculated by multiplying 30 minutes by the number of candidates; and*
 - (6) no Member shall be entitled to speak other than in accordance with the provisions of this sub-paragraph.”.*

4. *In paragraph (7) delete the first sentence and substitute therefor:*

“On a proposition to elect a Chairman or members of a Non-Government Body, the Presiding Officer shall invite Members to propose eligible candidates.”.
