

# Small Car Parking



## Small Spaces for Small Cars in St Peter Port



### What is Small Car Parking?

As part of the Road Transport Strategy, small car parking was introduced to provide dedicated preferentially located parking spaces for small cars in the centre of St Peter Port. The scheme encourages the use of smaller vehicles in the Island as they can bring environmental benefits and are better suited to our narrow roads.



### How does the scheme work?

If the width or length of your vehicle does not exceed the dimensions indicated on the sign then you are entitled to use the spaces. Please park within the marked bays and ensure your vehicle does not extend beyond the bay markings or encroach into the manoeuvring area or buffer zone between parallel parking spaces.

There is a range of vehicles that fit within these spaces. Typical examples are given later.

## Where is the parking located?

There are a number of car parks in St Peter Port with a small vehicle parking section and a number of narrower streets also have sections dedicated to smaller vehicles where some width restrictions also apply. Each zone can be identified by the “Small Car Parking” signs and road markings and each sign displays the dimension of the vehicles permitted to use the bays.



The below table sets out the location, duration of the zone, maximum width & length of vehicles permitted and the number of spaces available.

## How will the scheme be enforced?

Each parking space will be marked out individually in accordance with the maximum vehicle dimensions permissible. It is an offence to park “in a manner contrary to that indicated by a parking sign or the white lines marked in the road” and, therefore, anyone parking a vehicle too large for the space would be committing an offence and may be reported or issued with a **Fixed Penalty Ticket**.
