Shooting	Owner or Occupier	All year	On own land
Shooting	Any person	All year	On private land only with the written permission of the owner or occupier
Shooting	Any person	Between 1 October and 31 January	Holder of a Hunting Permit only on land specified in the Permit
Shooting	Visitor	All year	Holder of a Visitor Temporary Permit on private land only with the written permission of the owner or occupier
Trapping	Owner or Occupier	All year	Own land. Net or cage trap only
Trapping	Any person	All year	On private land only with the written permission of the owner or occupier Net or cage trap only
Trapping	Any person	Between 1 October and 31 January	Public land. Net or cage trap only.

### NOTES

The approved method of shooting is by means of using a shotgun or a low powered air rifle (less than 12 ft/lbs) or air pistol (less than 6 ft/lbs), provided that the person using a shotgun is the holder of a shot gun certificate.

Rabbits that are trapped alive by be killed using a slaughtering instrument specifically designed for killing or stunning and killing rabbits or dislocation of the neck or exsanguination and a slaughtering instrument.
