

SCHOOL UNIFORM GRANT GUIDANCE: SEPTEMBER 2023 – JULY 2024

Further to your request for assistance with school uniform, please find overleaf an application form which you will need to complete and return to this office.

Listed below are the names of suppliers of school uniforms. When entering the items of clothing and footwear that you require for your child/children, please also enter the name of the shop/supplier where you wish to obtain these items from.

Once you have submitted your completed application form to this office, you will be advised, in due course, of whether you are entitled to a grant.

Please note that a full uniform grant, where given, is for a full academic year and consists of:

Primary Secondary 2 pairs trousers/skirts 2 pairs trousers/skirts 2 polo shirts 2 shirts/blouses 1 sweatshirt/cardigan 1 jumper/PE hoodie 1 PE shorts & top 1 blazer* 1 pair trainers (Years 1-6) 1 tie 1 pair shoes 1 PE shorts/skort & top 1 pair trainers 1 pair shoes

- Not all applicants will be eligible for a full uniform grant.
- It may be possible to assist with the funding of football boots, rugby shirts and football socks for secondary school pupils if these are essential items required by the school. A PE jumper or hoodie can also be issued in place of a school jumper where required. However, there is a limit to the amount of grant payable per child and these additional items may exceed the full grant. Comparing supplier prices may be advisable in this case.
- Other than in exceptional circumstances, items of uniform that have been damaged or outgrown will not be replaced.

^{*}Every pupil who received a blazer between July 2022 and July 2023 will not be entitled to one this academic year.
