INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. This register must be kept by the employer under the provisions of the Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Law, 1994, in regard to every employee who uses a Poisonous Substance.
- 2. Enter name and address of all employees using Poisonous Substances on first page. Self-employed contractors should record their own details in this section.
- 3. Before any use of a poisonous substance, the employer or contractor must carry out a site specific risk assessment to complement the COSHH assessment and environmental assessments required under other legislation.
- 4. Immediately after a Poisonous Substance has been used, relevant entries must be made on the pages headed "RECORD OF POISONOUS SUBSTANCES USED'.
- 5. Details of sickness and accident, which may be attributable to the use of Poisonous Substances, are to be entered on the last page headed 'ACCIDENTS OR SUSPECTED POISONING'.
- 6. IN ANY CASE OF SUSPECTED POISONING OR ABSENCE OF AN EMPLOYEE WHICH MAY BE ATTRIBUTABLE TO THE USE OF A POISONOUS SUBSTANCE NOTIFY THE MEDICAL OFFICER OF HEALTH AT ONCE (TELEPHONE 725241).
- 7. Any accident arising out of the use of any Poisonous Substance must be reported by phone to the HSE on 234567 and confirmed in writing to the Health & Safety Executive, The Committee *for* Employment & Social Security forthwith.
- 8. For the definition of "Poisonous Substance" please refer to the back page of this Register.
- 9. The calibration of PS equipment must be recorded in the RECORD OF CALIBRATION.
- 10. The 5-yearly thorough examination must be recorded under, "RECORD OF 5-YEARLY THOROUGH EXAMINATION REPORT"; otherwise copies of the Thorough Examination Report must be kept with the Register.

POISONOUS SUBSTANCES

The Control of Poisonous Substances (Guernsey) Regulations, 2014

Declaration of poisonous substances.

- 2. (1) Subject to paragraphs (2) and (3), the following substances are poisonous substances for the purposes of the Law
 - (a) any pesticide, or
 - (b) any substance, preparation or organism prepared or used for any of the following purposes -
 - (i) protecting plants, food, or wood or other plant products from harmful organisms,
 - (ii) regulating the growth of plants,
 - (iii) giving protection against harmful creatures,
 - (iv) rendering such creatures harmless,
 - (v) controlling organisms with harmful or unwanted effects on water systems, buildings or other structures, or on manufactured products, or
 - (vi) protecting animals against ectoparasites,

as if it were a pesticide.
