We accept applications from students with a wide range of qualifications and a combination of qualifications.

Please check information below to see some examples of how these points can be achieved.

1. Minimum A*A* or BBC from two or three GCE A levels/Applied GCE A levels

2. Irish Leaving Certificate subjects. You must have passed a minimum of five subjects at either Higher or Ordinary Level to a maximum of seven.

3. Scottish Highers and Advanced Highers. You will require a minimum of two Advanced Highers or three Highers and a maximum of five Scottish higher qualifications.

4. National Extended Diploma minimum two, maximum three subjects. D*D* or DMM.

5. Access to Nursing qualification, or in a related subject, which must include 45 credits at level 3, of which all 45 must be at Merit or higher.

Additional Entry Criteria:

All candidates must be able to demonstrate literacy and numeracy. This will normally be through the possession of Maths and English GCSE, with a score of 4 (Grade C if awarded prior to 2017).

We also accept functional skills or key skills and equivalency tests by Equivalency Testing, A Star Teachers or any other appropriately accredited provider.

Further Requirements

You must be in a position to work for the Committee for Health and Social care, The States of Guernsey for 3 years after completion.

To begin the programme you must also complete a satisfactory enhanced DBS Check, Occupational Health Check, and provide suitable references

You are also required to provide evidence of study within the last 5 years

You are required to demonstrate that you have experience of working - this does not have to be in the field of health care.

Entrance Test and Interview

Entry onto this programme requires a skills test and interview:

- If your application is successfully shortlisted, you will be invited to attend a Maths and English test at The Institute. These tests are compulsory even if you meet our Maths and English GCSE application requirements.
- If you pass these tests, you will be invited to attend an assessed group discussion and individual interview.
