

In each of these examples the patient would have received exactly the same care/treatment/investigations and had the same outcome.

### Example One

If a patient walked in with chest pain on a Tuesday afternoon before 1st March 2017

Consultation fee:	£49.50
Intermediate procedure/operations:	£131.05
Simple Injection	£12.60
Complex Injection:	£25.50
ECG Performed	£37.60
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£256.25</b>

If a patient walked in with chest pain on a Tuesday afternoon after 1st March 2017

Attendance, Assessment Fee	£55.00
Major Category (Management of Chest Pain)	£165.00
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£220.00</b>

### Example Two

If a patient walked in with a finger injury on a Sunday afternoon before 1st March 2017

Consultation fee:	£103.80
Minor procedure/operations:	£67.85
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£171.65</b>

If a patient walked in with a finger injury on a Sunday afternoon after 1st March 2017

Attendance and Assessment fee	£110.00
Minor Category (Management of Minor wound)	£45.00
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£155.00</b>

### Example Three

If a patient is brought in seriously injured after a car accident 23:30 on a Friday night before 1st March 2017

Consultation fee:	£162.65
Major procedure/operations:	£256.95
Complex Injection:	£25.50
ECG Performed	£37.60
Intravenous Infusion	£58.85
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£541.55</b>

If a patient is brought in seriously injured after a car accident 23:30 on a Friday night after 1st March 2017

Attendance and Assessment fee	£165:00
Critical Category (Management of Major Trauma)	£340:00
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£505:00</b>

### Example Four

A patient presents Saturday morning with abdominal pain before 1st March 2017

Consultation fee:	£49.50
Intermediate procedure/operations:	£131.05
Complex Injection:	£25.50
Intravenous Infusion	£58.85
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£264.90</b>

A patient presents Saturday morning with abdominal pain after 1st March 2017

Attendance and Assessment fee	£110.00
Major Category (Management of Acute Abdominal pain)	£165.00
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>£275.00</b>
