- + Positive Behaviour Support Team
- + St Martin's Day Service
- + Short Break Service
- + Accommodation and support service

The service also supports service users to live in a variety of settings, such as residential homes, personal tenancies and extra care housing. The support offered varies from a few hours social support, to 24 hour care for individuals with more complex needs.
