*To amend the Proposition as follows –*

- (a) by numbering the Proposition as "1.", and*
- (b) by inserting the following Proposition immediately thereafter –*

- "2. To direct the Committee for Home Affairs, before the end of March 2018, to –*
  - a. review those provisions of the Population Management (Guernsey) Law, 2016 and any associated legislation, which define the categories of persons who are regarded as "Permanent Residents" for the purposes of the Law by reason of birth within Guernsey or being, or becoming, first resident in Guernsey as minors, and*
  - b. report back to the States by way of submission of a Policy Letter, together with suitable Propositions, recommending amendments to the Law and any associated legislation, which will have the effect of ensuring that for the purposes of qualification as a "Permanent Resident" under the legislation, all children born in Guernsey are treated equally and all children first resident in the island as minors are treated equally. "*
