REQUEST UNDER THE CODE OF PRACTICE FOR ACCESS TO PUBLIC INFORMATION

Request sent on January 24th 2017:

I would like to know what Guernsey Health & Social Service use to seal their bags of clinical waste, whether it is clinical waste seals or something else.

I would also like to know who currently supplies these to the service, and if possible how many the Service uses, and how much they cost.

Lastly I would like to know which department and, if possible, who within that department is responsible for their purchase.

States of Guernsey response sent February 1st 2017:

I can confirm that in 2016, Health and Social Care used 18,400 200mm x 4.8 mm white cable ties to seal clinical waste bags.

The cost £1.44 per hundred (so £264.96 for the year). The cable ties are sourced from a local company – Guernsey Fibreglass.
