Policy Council papers regarding financial transformation programme savings:

- Policy Council memorandum to Chief Minister and Members of the Policy Council – FTP – portfolio definition and base lining, February 2013
The policy council approved the recommendations of this paper.
- Policy Council memorandum to Chief Minister and Members of the Policy Council – FTP: Savings from Higher Education Grant Funding, April 2013
The recommendation was rejected by Policy Council and it was agreed to include the forecast value savings from grant subsidy as a FTP saving.
- Policy Council memorandum to Chief Minister and Members of the Policy Council – Proposed transfer of service delivery costs from HSSD general revenue to social security fund, July 2013.
The Policy Council agreed to the recommendations set out in the Policy Council paper.
- HSSD visiting consultants project – FTP savings £650,000, April 2014.
The Policy Council agreed that the financial benefits from the transfer of responsibility for Visiting Consultants should remain as a FTP saving.
