### **Increase in Fees and Charges from 01<sup>st</sup> August 2017**

#### **The Public Transport (Fees) (Guernsey) Regulations, 2017**

Following a review of its fees and charges the Environment and Infrastructure has decided to implement the following revised charges for **passenger transport** related services with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017:

- **Permit to Drive a Public Service Vehicle:**
  - **Application fee** (first time) for a permit to drive a public service vehicle (£10.00);
  - **Island knowledge test** first time (£50.00) second time (Free) then a 2 month gap and start from scratch (£50.00)
  - **Examination of ability to drive a public service vehicle** (£70.00 per test period or a reduced fee of £10 per test period where a driving test for a motor vehicle of a class in category D or D1 is taken on the same day);
  - **Grant of a 4 year permit** (first time) to drive a public service vehicle (£68.00)
  - **Renewal of a 4 year permit** to drive a public service vehicle (£68.00);
  - **Annual renewal** fee of a permit to drive a public service vehicle in relation persons over 60 (£17.00)
  
- **Road Service and Vehicle Licensing:**
  - **Grant of a first time Road Service Licence Application** (£30.00);
  - **Amendments** to a Road Service Licence (£30.00);
  - **Grant or renewal** fee for a public service vehicle licence (£40.00);
  - **Temporary** public service vehicle licence (£17.00);
  - **Permanent transfer of a public service vehicle licence** (£17.00);
  - **Transfer of a public service vehicle licence** to a new owner of a motor vehicle (£20.00);
  - **Examination of a public service vehicle** (£30.00);
  - **Subsequent re-examination** of a public service vehicle (£50.00);
  - **Examination of a taximeter** (£15.00).
