REQUEST UNDER THE CODE OF PRACTICE FOR ACCESS TO PUBLIC INFORMATION

Request sent on August 10th 2017:

Following the threat of a strike at Les Beaucamps School earlier this year, which I believe was prompted by the results of a wellbeing survey at the school. I'd like to request the results of this survey if they are centrally held and available?

States of Guernsey response sent on August 17th 2017:

Further to your request under the Code of Practice for Access to Public Information, please see below for a response from Education Services.

The Wellbeing survey you reference was completed by staff at Les Beaucamps High on the basis that it would not be shared beyond the school.

As a result of that assurance, the survey was completed by almost all staff. The results are for internal use only and are being used by a staff group to recommend improvements. The findings of the survey have been shared with the union representative to assist with conciliation.

Given the circumstances outlined above, there are two exemptions of the Code that have been applied to your request. Please see below for further details.
