This holistic approach can enable children to obtain the maximum benefit from their education and achieve their full potential.

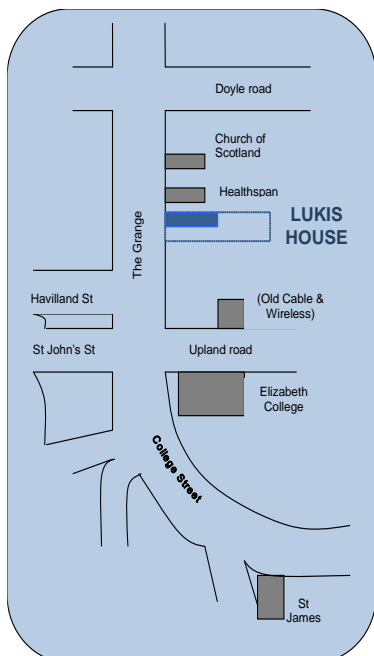
