ORDINANCE LAID BEFORE THE STATES

THE MALI (RESTRICTIVE MEASURES) (GUERNSEY) ORDINANCE, 2017

In pursuance of the provisions of the proviso to Article 66A(1) of The Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, "The Mali (Restrictive Measures) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2017", made by the Policy & Resources Committee on the 31st October, 2017, is laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Ordinance is made under the European Communities (Implementation) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994. The Ordinance gives effect to EU Regulation No. 2017/1770 of the 28th September, 2017 ("the 2017 Regulation") concerning restrictive measures against the Mali.

The Ordinance was made by the Policy & Resources Committee in exercise of its powers under Article 66A(1) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and came into force on the 31st October, 2017. Under the proviso to Article 66A(1) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, the States of Deliberation have the power to annul the Ordinance.

STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS LAID BEFORE THE STATES

The States of Deliberation have the power to annul the Statutory Instruments detailed below.

No. 93 of 2017

THE CIVIL CONTINGENCIES (CONTINGENCY PLANNING) (INFORMATION ARRANGEMENTS) (BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY) REGULATIONS, 2017

In pursuance of Sections 3 and 19 of the Civil Contingencies (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012a, The Civil Contingencies (Contingency Planning) (Information Arrangements) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Regulations, 2017, made by the Civil Contingencies Authority on 27th September 2017, is laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations are made under Part 2 of the Civil Contingencies (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2012 ("the Law"), and place a duty on the Committee *for* Home Affairs to maintain arrangements to warn the public and provide information to the public if an emergency under the Law is likely to occur or has occurred.

They come into force on the 27th September, 2017.

No. 96 of 2017

THE POPULATION MANAGEMENT (EMPLOYMENT PERMIT APPLICATIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2017

In pursuance of Sections 21(3) and (8), and 77, of the Population Management (Guernsey) Law, 2016, The Population Management (Employment Permit Applications) (Amendment) Regulations, 2017, made by the Committee *for* Home Affairs on 30th October 2017, is laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations change the period in respect of which a standard late payment fee in respect of an application for an Employment Permit is payable, from between four and fourteen days after the relevant person commenced employment, to between eight and fourteen days after employment commenced.

These Regulations come into force on the 1st November, 2017.
