States of Guernsey response sent on December 14th 2017:

Following your request made under the Code of Practice on Access to Public Information, please note the below explanation from the Senior Responsible Officer on the project.

It is clear that the previous PMO report was published as an exception and the Minister of the then Treasury & Resources Department makes that clear in his press statement. PMO reports are the same as a range of project management reports (OBC/FBC etc) and are part of the good governance of States projects. These are internal papers used to ensure project boards have up-to-date information on which to base discussions as the project progresses. Such documents are covered by exemption 2.4 of the Code.

1. Section 2.4 - Information whose disclosure would harm the frankness and candour of internal discussion, including: - Specifically internal opinion, advice, recommendation, consultation and deliberation;

The requester submitted an appeal against the use of an exemption. The Policy & Resources Committee considered the appeal and upheld the original decision.
