## The Options in the Referendum

The States has agreed to hold a multi-option referendum on the method of electing People's Deputies to the States of Deliberation. The draft legislation underpinning this referendum – the *Electoral System Referendum (Guernsey) Law, 2018* – was presented and approved by the States of Deliberation on 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2018. It is intended that the referendum will be held on **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2018**.

The referendum will ask the electorate which of the following options should be used to elect Deputies:

Option A Option B	<ul> <li>1 island-wide electoral district to elect 38 Deputies</li> <li>An election would be held every 4 years for all Deputies at once</li> <li>Each voter would have 38 votes at each election</li> <li>Each Deputy would serve for 4 years.</li> <li>7 electoral districts to elect 38 Deputies</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>An election would be held every 4 years for all Deputies at once</li> <li>Each voter would have 5 or 6 votes at each election (number of votes dependent on the size of the population of the district)</li> <li>Each Deputy would serve for 4 years.</li> </ul>
Option C	<ul> <li>Electoral Districts: <ul> <li>1 island-wide electoral district to elect 10 island-wide Deputies; and</li> <li>7 electoral districts to elect 28 district Deputies</li> </ul> </li> <li>Elections would be held every 4 years for all Deputies, with the election for the island-wide Deputies taking place first and the election for the district Deputies taking place at a later date</li> <li>Each voter would have: <ul> <li>10 votes for island-wide Deputies; and</li> <li>3, 4 or 5 votes for district Deputies in their own electoral district (number of votes dependent on the size of the population of the district)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Each Deputy would serve for 4 years.</li> </ul>
Option D	<ul> <li>4 electoral districts to elect 38 Deputies</li> <li>An election would be held every 4 years for all Deputies at once</li> <li>Each voter would have 9, 10 or 11 votes at each election (number of votes dependent on the size of the population of the district)</li> <li>Each Deputy would serve for 4 years.</li> </ul>
Option E	<ul> <li>1 island-wide electoral district to elect 38 Deputies</li> <li>An election would be held every 2 years for a third of Deputies each time</li> <li>Each voter would have 12 or 13 votes at each election</li> <li>Each Deputy would serve for 6 years.</li> </ul>
