THE LIBYA (RESTRICTIVE MEASURES) (GUERNSEY) ORDINANCE, 2016

In pursuance of the provisions of the proviso to Article 66A(1) of The Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, "The Libya (Restrictive Measures) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2016", made by the Legislation Select Committee on the 2nd February, 2016, is laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Ordinance is made under the European Communities (Implementation) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994 and, subject to certain modifications, gives effect in Guernsey to Council Regulation (EU) No. 2016/44 of the 18th January, 2016, concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya.

The Ordinance was made by the Legislation Select Committee in exercise of its powers under Article 66(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and came into force on the 2nd February, 2016. Under the proviso to Article 66A(1) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, the States of Deliberation have the power to annul the Ordinance.
