### WHO CAN ACCESS A SERVICE


The Reparative Care Team provide direct therapeutic services to Looked After and Adopted children and their families. We also provide services for children whose carers are in receipt of a residence order allowance.

The NSPCC 'Letting the Future In' therapeutic programme is for any child in Guernsey who has experienced child sexual abuse.

#### OUR STORY

The Children & Young People's Plan 2017- 2022 outlines the way in which the Children & Family Community Services will meet the requirements of 'the Children Law' (2008). The Reparative Care Team forms part of the Corporate Parenting Strategy and Children & Young People's Plan in line with the 2020 vision. Additionally the Adoption Reform Law will require a legal framework around adoption support services provided to

Some children who do not live in the care of their birth parents may have had a difficult start in life. The Reparative Care Team works with these children and their carers to understand their emotional and psychological needs to support the recovery of developmental traumas.

In order to support carers and help create change, the Reparative Care Team provides evidence based interventions that best meet the needs of these children and their families.


