

About your appeal

Under section 17 of the Parochial Collection of Waste (Guernsey) Law, 2015 an occupier who receives a civil penalty notice may appeal to the Parochial Appeals Tribunal.

To appeal, you must complete this appeal form and return it, together with the appeal fee of £25.00 to the address shown on the form. The completed form, any accompanying documents and the appeal fee must be received before the end of a period of 28 days starting with the date on which the civil penalty notice was issued.

You should include the following documents with your appeal:

- A copy of any warning notice which may have been issued
- A copy of the civil penalty notice
- A copy of any other correspondence, including emails, between you, your parish or the Waste Disposal Authority in relation to the matter/s which is/are subject of the civil penalty notice
- Any photographs you may wish the Tribunal to consider as part of your appeal
- Any other material you believe is relevant to your appeal.

- 4. Please complete all relevant sections of this form and attach all the supporting material, together with the administrative fee of £25. Your cheque should be made payable to the "States of Guernsey". Please note, if you are appealing the issue of more than one civil penalty notice, a separate appeal fee is payable for each civil penalty notice appealed.
- **5.** If you do not provide the necessary evidential documentation with this application form it may delay your appeal.
