ELECTION OF JURAT

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 (2) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, and section 9 (1) of the Royal Court (Reform) (Guernsey) Law, 2008, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace David Percy Langley Hodgetts L.V.O. who has ceased to hold office by reason of age on the 15th July 2019 but who has been appointed by the Royal Court as a Juré-Justicier Suppléant.
