INTRODUCTION

When to use this form?

If you undertake an operation, as described in Schedule 2 of The Environmental Pollution (Air Pollution) Ordinance, 2019 as a prescribed operation which may involve the risk of environmental pollution then you are required to hold a licence under Part III of the Environmental Pollution (Guernsey) Law, 2004.

In order for a licence you must complete this application form and include all supporting information as specified or as requested by the Director of Environmental Health and Pollution Regulation.

The appropriate fee must be enclosed with the application to enable it to be processed further. When complete return the application to:
