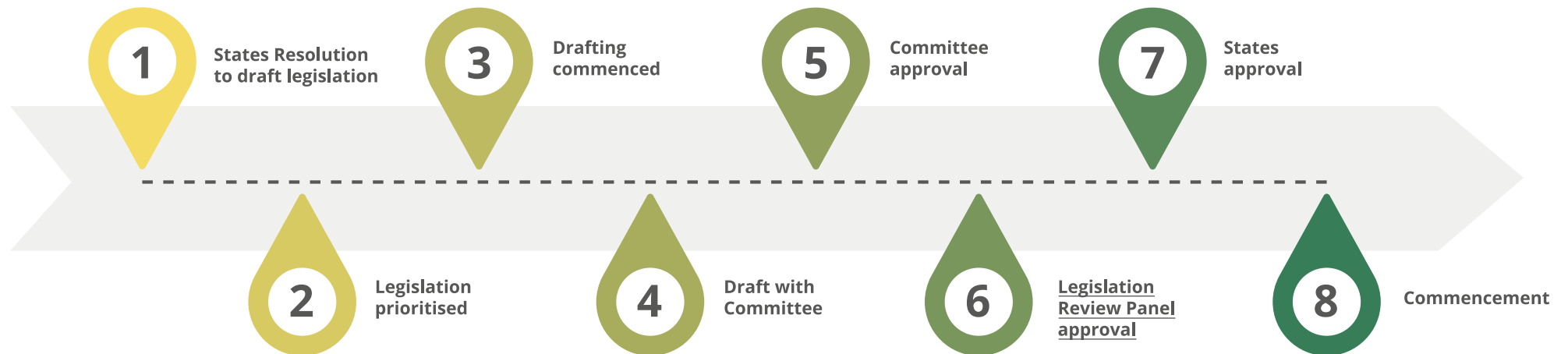


# Overview of the process to draft new or amend existing legislation

From States of Deliberation Resolution to commencement



The stages set out above capture the main steps required to prepare legislation. The stages start from the point when the States of Deliberation has directed that a piece of legislation is to be drafted (Stage 1) to when that piece of legislation comes into force (Stage 8).

# Legislation drafting in progress

In priority category – as at 12th November 2019

The table below captures the progress of legislation that the States of Deliberation has directed be drafted. The priority given relates to the drafting priority of that piece of legislation and these are grouped according to priority category (high, medium, low or not yet prioritised) and not in order of priority.

**Reform of Health Care Funding**

Transfer of certain functions under Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 and Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978 from the Committee for Employment & Social Security to the Committee for Health & Social Care; repeal of provisions relating Medical Benefit, Specialist Medical Benefit, Physiotherapy Benefit, Alderney Hospital Benefit and travelling allowance grant; amendment of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 to empower the Committee for Health & Care to determine conditions and other matters relating to pharmaceutical benefit and supply of medical appliances by resolution or regulation. As an interim measure the responsibility for the provision of benefits under the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990 and for Travelling Allowance Grants under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978 will be transferred from CESS to CHSC during 2019 by way of Ordinance under the Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) Law, 1991
