What is the current state of play and point of progress in the agreed desire of representatives of the States of Guernsey and the States of Alderney to look at reviewing updating and even replacing the terms and arrangements of the so-called 1948 Agreement?

Has every effort been made to ensure both Parliamentary Assemblies feel comfortable and agreeable about the process?

### **Question 3**

Will the commitment by Guernsey to provide a working airfield airport, transferred services which include a fully functioning and quality primary and secondary school at St Anne's and a modern medical service including appropriate accident and emergency cover be non-negotiable items for both parties?
