### Introduction

An Outstanding Resolution is one that requires further action, by a particular end point, before being fully discharged. These are often where one or more States Committees are directed to do something specific. The below table shows a summary of all Resolutions that are Outstanding by lead Committee (as at 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2023) and the number of those Outstanding that involve action by more than one Committee.
