Explanatory Note

The Committee considers that the "Exit from Lockdown – a framework for lifting the COVID-19 restrictions in the Bailiwick of Guernsey" ("the Framework") is best considered in the context of the Bailiwick's broader strategic priorities in supporting economic, social, environmental and cultural rejuvenation as the Bailiwick emerges from the immediate effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.
