## **Access to Public Information request:**

## Request for information:

I am requesting the following information under the Code of Practice for Access to Public Information.

I would like to see the accounts for 2019/20 for the States-run airline Aurigny (or whatever the most recent accounts available are). As a States-run airline, that needs to be held accountable to the taxpayer, I believe it is in the public interest for these to be made available in the public domain to show the impact the coronavirus pandemic has had on the airline's finances and what, if any, subsequent losses are for this year or what the projected losses are estimated to be.

## Response:

Response from States Trading Assets:

Auringy's 2019 losses (£9.7m) were disclosed in the States of Guernsey Accounts for last year which were debated by the States in July (Billet d'Etat XV of 2020);

In accordance with established arrangements, the full accounts are only published after the Company's Annual General Meeting;

The AGM was held last Thursday (10<sup>th</sup> September) and the accounts for the Aurigny Group (Cabernet) were published on the Aurigny website on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> September: https://www.aurigny.com/about-us/annual-accounts
