

Special import arrangements for animals entering the Bailiwick of Guernsey

Animals* imported into the Bailiwick of Guernsey must be pre-notified in writing to the Office of Environmental Health and Pollution Regulation.

*excluding non-commercial movement of pet dogs, cats or ferrets originating from within the Customs Union – details on commercial vs non-commercial pet travel available here.

Provide the information below by email with 'Animal notification' as the subject line to svo@gov.gg

The notification can be made as soon as the information is available, but must be made at least **24 hours** in advance of the animal(s) arriving in the Bailiwick.

Any health certificates, other official documents or attestations, or any other supporting documentation should also be attached to the Animal notification email.
