## \*Prohibited goods

There are some goods that you cannot bring into Guernsey. They will be seized by Customs and you may be prosecuted. These goods include:

- •Illegal drugs such as heroin, cocaine, cannabis and derivatives, synthetic cannabinoids, amphetamines, ketamine, LSD and MDMA (ecstasy)
- •Offensive Weapons such as flick knives, butterfly knives, knuckledusters, sword sticks, batons, throwing stars, samurai swords and some martial arts equipment
- ·Self-defence sprays i.e. pepper spray, CS gas, mace
- •Electric shock devices such as stun guns
- Indecent and obscene materials

## \*\*Restricted goods

Some goods are restricted and you will need a specific licence to bring them into Guernsey. Without such a licence they may be seized by Customs and you may be prosecuted. These goods include:

- Firearms and component parts of firearms, ammunition and explosives (including fireworks)
- · Animals & Birds
- Certain medicinal products (including prescription medication)
- · Cash including bullion, travellers cheques and precious metals
- Endangered Species whether alive or dead, including goods made from them like fur, ivory and reptile leather.
- Uncooked meats and poultry
- Certain plants, trees, shrubs, potatoes, fruit and vegetables
