IF YOU HAVE ANY ITEMS TO DECLARE OR NON-BRITISH NATIONALS ON BOARD WHO HAVE ARRIVED FROM OUTSIDE THE COMMON TRAVEL AREA OF THE U.K., ISLE OF MAN, REPUBLIC OF IRELAND OR THE CHANNEL ISLANDS. THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE MASTER OF THE VESSEL AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AFTER ARRIVAL OR BEFORE ANY PERSON GOES ASHORE.

NOTES

(1) Customs Laws & Regulations require that you make a Customs declaration for all goods (which could include the vessel itself) from outside the Customs Union, that you intend to permanently import into the Bailiwick of Guernsey, and which are over your personal allowance of £270. You must also declare to the all wines, spirits, tobacco goods and any prohibited or restricted goods, whether they are to be retained on board for your personal consumption or landed in the Bailiwick of Guernsey. **PROHIBITED GOODS** There are some goods that you can't bring into the Bailiwick of Guernsey. They'll be seized by Customs and you may be prosecuted. These goods include: **Illegal drugs, Offensive Weapons, Self-defence sprays, Electric shock devices and Indecent and obscene materials. RESTRICTED GOODS** Some goods are restricted and you'll need a specific licence to bring them into the Bailiwick of Guernsey. Without such a licence they may be seized by Customs and you may be prosecuted. These goods include: **Firearms** and component parts of firearms, ammunition and explosives (including fireworks); **Animals & Birds; Prescription medication** from outside the United Kingdom Crown Dependencies Customs Union; **Cash** including bullion, travellers cheques, and precious metals; **Endangered species** whether alive or dead, including goods made from them like fur, ivory and reptile leather; **Uncooked meats and poultry; certain plants, trees, shrubs, potatoes, fruit and vegetables.** For more information go to www.gov.gg/gba

(2) The landing of animals from vessels arriving in the Bailiwick of Guernsey directly or indirectly from elsewhere, other than from the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland, the Isle of Man or Jersey, is strictly prohibited. Any person having charge or control of any vessel, which has arrived from outside the places listed and is in harbour in the Islands or at anchor or moored in the territorial waters of the Islands, must ensure that any animal aboard that vessel is, at all times, restrained and kept securely confined within an enclosed part of the vessel, from which it cannot escape. (3) Any person on board carrying cash of £10,000 or more, or the equivalent amount in other currency must complete a cash declaration form. Cash declaration forms and Customs leaflets may be obtained from any Customs Red point or Customs Office. For more information go to www.gov.gg/gba
