IDP no longer legally required IDP still required

For those countries no longer requiring an IDP some have restricted the period for which temporary exemption is granted:

<sup>1</sup>for periods up to 30 days

<sup>2</sup>for periods up to 90 days

<sup>3</sup> for periods up to six months

For peace of mind when driving abroad you can still obtain an IDP at a cost of £13 from Driver and Vehicle Licensing at Edward T Wheadon House, Le Truchot, St. Peter Port in the above accepted countries should you wish. In some exempted countries you may still be asked to provide an IDP if you are hiring a car.
