1. Could the Committee please publish the number of licences granted each month for the importation of medicinal cannabis since this became permissible?

2. Could the Committee detail the resources required to process medicinal cannabis licences?

Since October 2020, medicinal cannabis licences have been processed by a permanent member of staff (1 WTE) in addition to their established post, with the support of bank staff (2.5 WTE).

A business case was recently submitted to the Committee *for* Health & Social Care to establish a licencing team that mirrors the resource set out above.

Further to the 3.5 WTE members of staff, the Chief Pharmacist commits 10-20 hours per week as the authoriser of licences and to communicate with patients, UK clinics, the Home Office and Guernsey Border Agency, as necessary.

3. Could the Committee advise an estimate of the cost of processing each medicinal cannabis licence application?

While applications vary in complexity, the average cost of processing each application is estimated at £55.
