REPLY BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COMMITTEE FOR HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE TO QUESTIONS POSED BY DEPUTY ST PIER PURSUANT TO RULE 14 OF THE RULES OF PROCEDURE

1. Will the Committee please publish the September 2021 report by SEW Consultancy Limited entitled "Learning following a local investigation into complaints from families about the use of safeguarding processes" together with the accompanying spreadsheet entitled "Learning Report Recommendations from Ms Walters report of November 2021"?

The Committee does not consider that it would be appropriate to publish the learning report in its current format due to the nature of the information it includes about the specific conditions of a small number of service users, which may make these service users or their families identifiable to others. Given the multi-disciplinary nature of safeguarding, it would also be appropriate to discuss the potential publication of the findings and/or recommendations of this report with the stakeholders referenced in the report before doing so.

The Committee is giving this matter further consideration and will provide an update to you as soon as it is able to do so.
