At the end of Proposition 17 i. add:

“subject to replacing the figure 382 with the figure 432, where it appears in relation to the recovery action entitled ‘Enhance domestic abuse services in line with the updated domestic abuse strategy (including a Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC) three-year pilot)’ in the 6<sup>th</sup> row, 4<sup>th</sup> column, relating to 2022, of the table headed “Keep the Island Safe and Secure” in Annex 3 of Appendix 8”

And

To insert a new Proposition 11A after proposition 11:

“11A. To direct stakeholder Committees to commit the appropriate operational resources required to establish a pilot Sexual Assault Referral Centre (SARC).”

**Rule 4(1) Information**

- a) The proposition contributes to the States’ objectives and policy plans to maintain a safe, inclusive and equal community.
- b) In preparing the proposition, consultation has been undertaken with the Policy & Resources Committee, the Committee *for* Health & Social Care, the Committee *for* Education Sport & Culture and the Committee *for* Home Affairs.

- c) The proposition has been submitted to Her Majesty's Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) This proposition sees a one-off increase in expenditure of £50,000 for 2022.

#### Explanatory Note

The of a SARC as one of the priority workstreams in the Domestic Abuse and Sexual Assault Strategy. This workstream was phased through the Government Work Plan (GWP) to deliver a pilot 2023-2025, with the increase in funding for these years reflected in the Finance & investment Plan.

Allocation of an additional £50,000 in 2022 will support preparation of the SARC launch in 2023, providing resourcing support and training costs.
