The Prevention of Discrimination (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2022

AMENDMENT

Proposed by: Deputy P J Roffey

Seconded by: Deputy H L de Saumarez

At the end of the Proposition add: “, subject to the amendments indicated below”.

1. In section 67 -

(a) in subsection (1), delete "or guidance",

(b) insert the following subsection (2) and renumber subsections (2) and (3) accordingly—

"(2) The Committee may issue guidance in respect of people’s rights and duties under this Ordinance, and such guidance may, without limitation, provide information about what is required in an accessibility action plan as required by section 37, or otherwise specify established standards of accessibility which would fulfil the duty imposed by that section."

Rule 4(1) information

a) The proposition contributes to the States’ objectives and policy plans as it is in line with the States strategic objective of introducing legislation to prevent discrimination.

b) The proposition has been submitted to His Majesty’s Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.

c) There are no financial implications to the States of carrying the proposal into effect.

This amendment enables the Committee *for* Employment & Social Security to issue non-statutory guidance on the Prevention of Discrimination (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2022.
