## Question

Having regard to the Committee's mandate for the oversight of the capital programme, in relation to the development of the new Sixth Form Centre, what ongoing rights, obligations and risks does the States of Guernsey have following the purported termination of a contract by the States with RG Falla?

## Response

The Policy & Resources Committee has responsibility for the oversight of the capital portfolio and not the management of the individual projects and programmes within it. As such, the Committee has had detailed discussions with the Committee *for* Education, Sport & Culture to understand the impact of the recent developments and the risks and issues they pose to the Transforming Education Programme and the States more broadly. The Policy & Resources Committee is confident that everything is being done to manage the situation and mitigate risks.

Given the ongoing contractual and legal review, it would be inappropriate to say anything further at this stage.
