Freedom of Information request regarding referrals to the Healthy Minds service

Request:

I would like to make an information request for the following points under the Freedom of Information code.

- The total number of people accessing the Healthy Minds service (through selfreferrals or GP referrals) in 2018
- The total number of people accessing the Healthy Minds service (through selfreferrals or GP referrals) in 2019
- The total number of people accessing the Healthy Minds service (through selfreferrals or GP referrals) in 2020
- The total number of people accessing the Healthy Minds service (through self-referrals or GP referrals) in 2021

Response provided by The Committee for Health & Social Care:

A self-referral pathway to the Healthy Minds Service was introduced in October 2019. This has generally seen a % reduction in the number of people referred to the service but who are not ready for therapy at that time so do not attend appointments. Although remote services were available during the Bailiwick lockdowns in 2020 and 2021, the circumstances of some individuals impacted their ability to access the service remotely and these years are therefore not considered typical.
