

STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS LAID BEFORE THE STATES

The States of Deliberation have the power to annul the Statutory Instruments detailed below.

No. 91 of 2022

THE AMALGAMATION AND MIGRATION OF COMPANIES (FEES PAYABLE TO THE GUERNSEY FINANCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2022

In pursuance of sections 66, 94, 535 and 538 of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008^a, “The Amalgamation and Migration of Companies (Fees Payable to the Guernsey Financial Services Commission) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022”, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development on 8th December, 2022, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations amend the Amalgamation and Migration of Companies (Fees payable to the Guernsey Financial Services Commission) Regulations, 2012 by increasing the fee payable to the Guernsey Financial Services Commission which must accompany an application for its consent for the amalgamation of companies pursuant to the provisions of Part VI of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008 and for the removal of a supervised company from the Register of Companies for the purposes of becoming registered as a company under the law of a district, territory or place outside Guernsey in accordance with the provisions of Part VII of that Law.

There continues to be no fee payable to the Guernsey Financial Services Commission when a non-Guernsey company migrates "inwardly" to become registered as a Guernsey company.

These Regulations came into force on the 1st January, 2023.

THE FINANCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION (LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIPS) (FEES) REGULATIONS, 2022

In pursuance of sections 45 and 113 of the Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013^a, “The Financial Services Commission (Limited Liability Partnerships) (Fees) Regulations, 2022”, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development on 8th December, 2022, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development, prescribe the fee payable to the Commission under the Limited Liability Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 2013 in relation to an application for the consent of the Commission for a supervised LLP to be removed from the Register.

These Regulations came into force on the 1st January 2023.

THE LIMITED PARTNERSHIPS (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2022

In pursuance of sections 36(1)(c), 43, and 44 of the Limited Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 1995^a, “The Limited Partnerships (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 2022”, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development on 8th December, 2022, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development, prescribe the fee payable to the Commission under the Limited Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 1995 in relation to an application for the consent of the Commission for a supervised limited partnership to be removed from the Register.

These Regulations came into force on the 1st January 2023.

THE PROTECTED CELL COMPANIES AND INCORPORATED CELL COMPANIES (FEES PAYABLE TO THE GUERNSEY FINANCIAL SERVICES COMMISSION) REGULATIONS, 2022

In pursuance of sections 438, 469, 535 and 538 of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008^a, “The Protected Cell Companies and Incorporated Cell Companies (Fees Payable to the Guernsey Financial Services Commission) Regulations, 2022”, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development on 8th December, 2022, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations prescribe the fees payable to the Guernsey Financial Services Commission by any person for consent for the conversion of a licensed company into a protected cell company or an incorporated cell company; for the conversion of an existing licensed protected cell company into an incorporated cell company; for the incorporation of a protected cell company or incorporated cell company; or for the conversion of a licensed protected cell company or incorporated cell company into a non-cellular company. The Regulations also specify a fee for the conversion of an existing cell of a protected cell company into a non-cellular company.

These Regulations came into force on the 1st January 2023.

THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS (CORONATION OF HIS MAJESTY KING CHARLES III) REGULATIONS, 2022

In pursuance of section 1A(1) of the Public Holidays Ordinance, 1994^a, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, “The Public Holidays (Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III)

Regulations, 2022”, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development on 20th December, 2022, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development, appoint Monday 8th May 2023 as a public holiday to mark the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III.

These Regulations came into force on the 21st December, 2022.

THE COMPANIES (ANNUAL VALIDATION) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 2022

In pursuance of sections 237A, 535 and 538 of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008^a, “The Companies (Annual Validation) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 2022”, made by the Committee *for* Economic Development on 20th December, 2022, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend the definition of high value asset in section 235 of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008.

These Regulations came into force on the 20th December, 2022.

THE PAROCHIAL ELECTIONS (SCHOOL COMMITTEES) (TORTEVAL) REGULATIONS, 2023

In pursuance of Articles 54(4) and 77C of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948a and section 3 of the Education (School Committees) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1970b, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, “The Parochial Elections (School Committees) (Torteval) Regulations, 2023” made by the States' Assembly & Constitution Committee on 19th January, 2023, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations provide for elections to the office of Douzenier to take place in the Parish of Torteval on the 16th February, 2023.

These Regulations also provide for elections of members to the committees of Forest Primary School and La Mare de Carteret Secondary School on the 16th February, 2023.

These Regulations came into force on the day they were made, 19th January 2023.

**THE FORFEITURE OF MONEY, ETC. IN CIVIL PROCEEDINGS (BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2022 (COMMENCEMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023**

In pursuance of section 5 of the Forfeiture of Money, etc. in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022, the Forfeiture of Money, etc. in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022 (Commencement) Regulations, 2023 made by the Committee *for* Home Affairs on 23rd January 2023, is laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend a typographical error in the Forfeiture of Money in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022 (Commencement etc.) Regulations, 2022. These Regulations come into force on 24th January, 2023.

**THE EUROPEAN UNION (SEA FISHERIES, ETC.) (BREXIT) (BAILIWICK OF GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2023**

In pursuance of section 11 (10) of The European Union (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2018, as amended, “The European Union (Sea Fisheries, etc.) (Brexit) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Regulations, 2023”, made by the Policy and Resources Committee on 24th January, 2023, are laid before the States.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These Regulations amend a typographical error in the Forfeiture of Money in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022 (Commencement etc.) Regulations, 2022. These Regulations come into force on 24th January, 2023.
