The States are asked:-

XIV.- To elect four sitting Members of the States as members of the Public Sector Remuneration Committee to serve until May 2008 in accordance with Rule 7 of the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees.

SCRUTINY COMMITTEE

MEMBERS

The States are asked:-

XV.- To elect eight sitting Members of the States as members of the Scrutiny Committee to serve until May 2008 in accordance with Rule 7 of the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees.

PAROCHIAL OUTDOOR ASSISTANCE BOARDS

NEW PRESIDENTS AND NEW MEMBERS

The States are asked:-

XVI.- To elect -

(1) members of the following Parochial Outdoor Assistance Boards to fill the vacancies which will arise on the 1st June, 2004, by reason of the expiration of the terms of office of the following members, who are eligible for re-election:

(2) a member of the St. Andrew's Parochial Outdoor Assistance Board to complete the unexpired portion of the term of office of Mr. H. C. Bougourd who has ceased to be a Douzenier, namely, to the 31st May, 2005.

(NB Only a sitting member of the States or a Jurat, Rector or Douzenier resident in their respective parishes is eligible for election under (1) and (2) above)

(3) from the States elected members of the Castel Parochial Outdoor Assistance Board, a President to fill the vacancy which will arise on the 1st June, 2004, by reason of the expiration of the term of office of Mr. H. J. Dorey.

(NB The States elected members are Messrs H. J. Dorey, C. Le Page, D. J. Ozanne, and the successor to Mr. K. J. Guille)

(4) from the States elected members of the St. Pierre-du-Bois Parochial Outdoor Assistance Board, a President to complete the unexpired portion of the term of office of Mr. A. L. Bougourd who is not seeking re-election under (1) above, namely, to the 31st May, 2005.

(NB The States elected members are Messrs S. Langlois, J. H. Lenfestey, M. C. Jeffreys and the successor to Mr. Bougourd).

ADMINISTRATIVE DECISIONS (REVIEW) (GUERNSEY) LAW, 1986

NEW CHAIRMAN AND DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF PANEL OF MEMBERS

The States are asked to decide:-

XVII.- To elect in accordance with the provisions of section 4(2) of the Administrative Decisions (Review) (Guernsey) Law, 1986-

- (1) A Chairman of the Panel of Members, who shall be a sitting member of the States of Deliberation and who has held a seat in the States for a period of three years or more, to complete the unexpired portion of the term of office of Deputy J. E. Langlois, who will cease to have a seat in the States, namely to the 31st May, 2004, and to commence a new term of office from the 1st June, 2004;
- (2) a Deputy Chairman of that Board, who shall be one of the Deans of the Douzaines but who shall not have a seat in the States, to fill the vacancy which will arise on the 1st June, 2004, by reason of the expiration of the term of office of Douzenier J. Domaille, who is eligible for re-election.

THE MACHINERY OF GOVERNMENT (TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS) (GUERNSEY) ORDINANCE, 2003 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDINANCE, 2004

The States are asked to decide:-

XVIII.- Whether they are of opinion to approve the draft Ordinance entitled "The Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003 (Commencement) Ordinance, 2004", and to direct that the same shall have effect as an Ordinance of the States.

THE MACHINERY OF GOVERNMENT (TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS) (GUERNSEY) ORDINANCE, 2003 (COMMENCEMENT) ORDINANCE, 2004

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1991^a and section 8 of the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003^b, hereby order:-

Commencement of Transfer of Functions Ordinance.

1. The Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003 shall come into force on the 6th May, 2004.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003 (Commencement) Ordinance, 2004.

NB Rule 20(1) of the Rules of Procedure of the States of Deliberation provides:

"The elections held quadrennially following each General Election of People's Deputies shall be held in the following order:

- (a) Chief Minister
- (b) Ministers
- (c) Deputy Chief Minister
- (d) Chairmen of Committees
- (e) Members of Departments
- (f) Members of Committees
- (g) Chairmen and Members of Non-Governmental Bodies

and the Chief Minister shall determine the order in which the Ministers and Chairmen are elected which same order shall be followed in electing Members of Departments and Members of Committees."

As the Chief Minister will only be elected on the 1st May these elections have been listed in the above order. At the States Meeting the Chief Minister may request the Presiding Officer to call the elections in the order he has determined.
