TO THE MEMBERS OF THE STATES OF ELECTION OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

I have the honour to inform you that a Meeting of the States of Election will be held at **THE ROYAL COURT HOUSE, on WEDNESDAY,** the **24**th **FEBRUARY 2010,** at 9.30am, for the purpose of electing a Jurat in the place of Jurat Derek Martin Le Page who, under the operation of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, ceased to hold office by reason of age on the 13th December, 2009.

Nominations must be in writing (the relevant forms are available at my office on request) and must be made and seconded by a Member of the States of Election or by a Douzenier¹ and must reach me by 4 p.m. on Friday 5th February 2010. A nomination must be accompanied by a certificate in writing, signed by the candidate, stating his or her willingness to serve in the office of Jurat if elected.

I remind you that, for the purpose of the election of a Jurat, the States of Election is composed of the following:

The Bailiff (The Bailiff is counted in the quorum but does not have an original vote)
The Jurats

The Rectors or Priests-in-Charge (subject to the provisions of the Reform (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1984)

H M Procureur

H.M. Comptroller

The People's Deputies

Thirty-four Douzaine Representatives elected for a particular meeting of the States of Election by their respective Douzaines, as follows:

From St Peter Port, nine.

From St Sampson, five.

From the Vale, five.

From the Castel, five.

From St Saviour, two.

From St Peter-in-the-Wood, one.

From Torteval, one.

From the Forest, one.

From St Martin, four.

From St Andrew, one.

Will the Constables of the above-mentioned Parishes kindly convene their respective Douzaines for the purpose of electing, for the Meeting of the 24th February 2010 the appropriate number of Douzaine Representatives and deliver to Her Majesty's Greffier not later than 3 p.m. on Tuesday, the 23rd February 2010, a certificate, signed by the Constables as to the Douzaine Representatives so elected.

Notice of nominations, as they are received, will be posted in the lobby of the Royal Court and, when the period for receiving nominations has expired, a further notice concerning all those received will be published in 'La Gazette Officielle'.
