The House Committee (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2008

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 1st August, 2008^a, and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1 of the Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1991^b and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:-

Transfer of functions.

1. The functions, rights and liabilities of the House Committee and of its Chairman arising under or by virtue of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended^c are transferred to and vested in, respectively, the States Assembly and Constitution Committee and its Chairman.

Savings and transitional provisions.

2. Anything done before the date of the commencement of this Ordinance or in the process of being done on that date by or in relation to the House Committee or its Chairman under or by virtue of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended shall have effect as if done or (as the case may be) may be

1. Parts I, III, IV and VI of, and the Schedule to, the Forfeiture of Money, etc in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2007 shall come into force on the 24th September 2008.

The Education (Compulsory School Age) (Guernsey)(No. 2) Ordinance, 2008

THE STATES LEGISLATION SELECT COMMITTEE, in exercise of the power conferred on the States by section 16(2) of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970^a and in exercise of the powers conferred on the Committee by Article 66(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948^b, and in pursuance of the States Resolution of the 10th May 2001^c, hereby orders:-

Effect of section 16(1) of Law of 1970.

1. It is hereby directed, subject to section 2, that section 16(1) of the Education (Guernsey) Law, 1970 (compulsory school age) shall have effect as if for each reference to "fifteen years" there were substituted "sixteen years".

Exception.

2. The substitutions referred to in section 1 shall not have effect in relation to a person who attained the age of 15 at any time from 1st September 2007 to 31st August 2008 inclusive except for such a person who stayed on at school at any time on or after 1st September, 2008.

Interpretation.

3. (1) In this Ordinance "school" shall have the same meaning as in

- (b) make such additional provision as they think fit for the purposes of carrying this Law into effect.".

Interpretation.

 (1) In this Ordinance, "the Law of 2007" means the Forfeiture of Money, etc in Civil Proceedings (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2007.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^d apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance throughout the Bailiwick.

by or on behalf of that person in the proceedings arising out of the prosecution.".

Amendment of section 38 of Law of 1987.

(3) Immediately before the words "create offences" in section 42A(3)(a), insert "subject to subsection (3A),".

(4) Immediately after section 42A(3) insert -

"(3A) The power conferred by subsection (3)(a) to create offences does not include power -

- (a) to provide for offences to be triable only on indictment,
- (b) to authorise the imposition, on summary conviction of an offence, of a term of imprisonment or a fine exceeding the limits of jurisdiction for the time being imposed on the Magistrate's Court by section 9 of the Magistrate's Court (Guernsey) Law, 2008, or
- (c) to authorise the imposition, on conviction on indictment of any offence, of a term of imprisonment exceeding two years.".

1. (1) In sections 18(10)(a), 19(7)(a), 20(4)(a) and 22(7)(a) of the Law of 2008 immediately after the words, figures and parentheses "or section 32(1)", insert "(but only in relation to a requirement imposed by or under this section)".

(2) Immediately after section 18(10) insert -

"(10A) A statement may not be used by virtue of subsection (10)(b) against a person unless -

- (a) evidence relating to it is adduced, or
- (b) a question relating to it is asked,

by or on behalf of that person in the proceedings arising out of the prosecution.".

- (c) improving or enhancing the investigation, prevention or detection of crime,
- (d) facilitating the instigation of, or otherwise for the purposes of, any criminal proceedings,
- (e) facilitating the detection, seizure and forfeiture of the proceeds of crime or assets intended for use in crime,

- (f) discharging any international obligation to which the Bailiwick is subject, or
- (g) assisting, in the interests of the public or otherwise, any authority which appears to the States to exercise in a place outside the Bailiwick functions corresponding to any of the functions of the Commission.".

(3) Immediately before the words "create offences" in section 30(4)(a), insert "subject to subsection (4A),".

(4) Immediately after section 30(4) insert -

"(4A) The power conferred by subsection (4)(a) to create offences does not include power -

- (a) to provide for offences to be triable only on indictment,
- (b) to authorise the imposition, on summary conviction of an offence, of a term of imprisonment or a fine exceeding the limits of jurisdiction for the time being imposed on the Magistrate's Court by section 9 of the Magistrate's Court (Guernsey) Law, 2008, or
- (c) to authorise the imposition, on conviction on indictment of any offence, of a term of imprisonment exceeding two years.".

Interpretation.

3. (1) In this Ordinance, "the Law of 2008" means the Registration of Non-Regulated Financial Services Businesses (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008.

(2) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^c applies to the interpretation of this Ordinance throughout the Bailiwick.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Non-Regulated Financial Services Businesses (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2008 (Amendment) Ordinance, 2008.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the same day as section 30 of the Law of 2008 comes into force.
