(N.B.

Paragraph 7(7) of the Rules relating to the Constitution and Operation of States Departments and Committees states:

"If a member elected by the States to a Department ... tenders his resignation from that office in a letter to the Minister of the Department ..., and does not include in that letter a request that the matter be debated by the States, his resignation shall automatically take effect on the election by the States of a new member of that Department ... in his place."

In this case Deputy Fallaize has not asked that the matter be debated.)
