

IN THE STATES OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

ON THE 29TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 2003

In accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, an election was held, by secret ballot, for the office of Jurat of the Royal Court to replace Mrs. Eileen May Glass who, under the operation of sub-section (1) of section (5) of the Royal Court of Guernsey (Miscellaneous Reform Provisions) Law, 1950, ceased to hold office by reason of age on the 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2003.
