During the year staffing within the Development Control team was reduced through implementation of Financial Transformation Programme recommendations and vacancies.
- 3. The "appeal result" statistic measures the proportion of dismissed appeals relative to all appeal decisions on planning applications (including any appeals conceded) over the report period. Dismissed appeals are those decided in favour of the Department.
