**Introduction**

This leaflet has been designed to help parents, carers and students to find out what support is available in Guernsey to help young people with special educational needs to make transition smoother.

Transition is a time when a young person is moving through establishments. Each young person is treated as an individual with varying levels of achievements. All young people receive support to help them plan their choices and decisions.

**Transition points include:**  
 Age 10/11: moving to Secondary School  
 Age 15/16: options when leaving school  
 Age 16+: what to do after leaving full time education

**The transition plan includes:**  
 A summary of achievement at school  
 A summary of the student's aspirations for the future  
 Realistic targets to help students make progress towards their goals  
 Action points for the student and people supporting the student.
