The Commerce and Employment Department in exercise of its powers under Section 8 of the Air Transport Licensing (Guernsey) Law 1995 hereby varies the above Guernsey Air Transport Licence* granted to:

Aurigny Air Services Limited

(a company registered in Jersey with company registration number 2994), authorising that person to operate aircraft to carry passengers on scheduled flights between Guernsey and the following point(s) in the British Islands:-

Bristol

The Licence is now subject to the following condition:-

- 1. That a service is provided using aircraft with a minimum capacity of 50 passenger seats and is operated on a year round basis consisting of a minimum of one rotation per day during the months of May to September and a minimum of four rotations per week during the months of October to April.**
- 2. That Condition 1 may be satisfied by occasional flights triangulating via a third point in accordance with any other licence the operator holds, in addition to direct flights.**
- 3. That the Licence is valid only if the licence holder has the minimum insurance cover as stipulated by the UK Civil Aviation Authority from time to time and has provided evidence of that insurance to the Commerce and Employment Department.**

*NOTES TO LICENCE HOLDER

1. THE HOLDER OF THIS LICENCE MUST HOLD A CAA LICENCE OR PERMISSION AUTHORISING IT TO FLY THE FLIGHTS IN QUESTION, OTHERWISE THE LICENCE SHALL CEASE TO BE VALID IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 9(1) OF THE LAW.
2. IF THIS LICENCE IS NOT USED WITHIN 6 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF GRANT, OR HAS NOT BEEN USED FOR 3 CONSECUTIVE CALENDAR MONTHS, IT MAY BE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 9(2)(B) OF THE LAW.
