- 3. The Licence may be operated between East Midlands Airport and Guernsey until 30 June 2011, after which this condition shall cease to be valid.**

- 2. IF THIS LICENCE IS NOT USED WITHIN 6 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF GRANT, OR HAS NOT BEEN USED FOR 3 CONSECUTIVE CALENDAR MONTHS, IT MAY BE REVOKED OR SUSPENDED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 9(2)(B) OF THE LAW.**
