In Proposition 1, to remove the word "and" at the end of paragraph (e), to replace the full stop at the end of paragraph (f) with "; and", and after paragraph (f) insert a new paragraph (g) -

"(g) the expression "houses in multiple occupation" should be used instead of the expression "lodging houses" to describe properties inscribed in Part D of the Housing Register.".

Explanatory Note

This amendment would require the term "houses in multiple occupation" to be used in the legislation to describe properties inscribed in Part D of the Housing Register, in place of the outdated term "lodging houses".
