#### **Coastal Defence Flood Studies**

To add a new Proposition 3 as follows:

“3. To agree that, in addition to the seven areas identified as vulnerable to coastal inundation in this Report, consideration be given to adding Perelle Bay, using the same weightings and analysis methodology set out in this Report, in order that it may be considered on the same basis as the other areas when future priorities are selected after St Sampson's and Belle Greve Bay.”

#### **Explanatory note**

The Environment Department are putting forward a strategy to prioritise areas which are at risk of flooding, seven areas have been identified to date, with St Sampson's and Belle Greve Bay being priorities 1 and 2. This amendment seeks to add Perelle Bay to the remaining list and allow it to be subjected to the same rigour, and weightings as the five remaining areas for consideration of work in the future.
